1. Introduction

This Addendum to the BRIO has been approved by the BIPT on the March 14th 2022.

It concerns a new section added to the BRIO. This new section refers to the end date of the BRIO. Beyond that date the BRIO is no more valid.

2. Section 1.4 is added as follows

1.4. End date of the BRIO

The BRIO service provision will stop to exist as from 31/12/2023. This concerns the BRIO (the Fixed Reference Interconnect Offer), all its addenda and all annexes (therefore also the Planning and Operations and the Service Agreement Level).

Orders relating to capacity increase or re-arrangement of the Interconnection will be accepted and executed only until 31/12/2022.

New requests for interconnection based on the BRIO interconnection offer will no longer be considered as reasonable as from 1/4/2022. We refer interested parties to the VoIP IC interconnection offer if interested to interconnect with Proximus.

Until 2 months after entry into force of this addendum, this is until 1/6/2022, Proximus will accept officially requests for the migration from TDM towards VoIP Interconnect. Both parties will agree on an acceptable planning lasting maximum 1 year and ending before 31/12/2023. Proximus will not close the TDM interconnection as long as this migration is not finalised.

Two months after the entry into force of this addendum, this is after 1/6/2022, any request for migrating an existing interconnection from TDM toward VoIP will no longer be considered as a reasonable request. Proximus will not guarantee a timely migration. In this case we reserve the right to close the TDM interconnection as from 31/12/2023 even before this migration to IP is finalised.
